

## The Foundations of Fellowship

These activities form the underpinnings of our Sunday morning and fellowship programs. They are simple, sociable one shot tasks which need lots of volunteers all year long. All members are requested to do one of these tasks at least four times per year. Please read the descriptions below, and check 4 activities for this church year - all four could be the same activity, or all different, or some combination! You will receive a post card at the beginning of each quarter with your assignment and instructions about how to sign up.

### Nursery Attendant

Play with our babies for an hour during one of the services to give their parents a break. It is very important that we have enough adult help for our nursery staff to assure a safe, loving environment for our littlest UU's. If few babies come to a particular service, you might be reassigned to preparing snacks, fixing toys or equipment, supervising the playground, or helping in the YRE office.

   

### Making Coffee

Arrive at church about 15 min. before the worship service to make coffee (and sometimes cold drinks) and set out the cups, sugar and creamer. Stay about 45 min. after the service to wash the cups and clean up the service area.

   

### Fellowship Events

Be on one of the crews which bring us our Fellowship Dinners and holiday celebrations. Be part of a team who sets up the tables, chairs, service area, and sometimes decorations, or helps with dishes, vacuuming, and taking down the tables and chairs. If you'd like to join one of our cook teams, then check the "Rotating Teams" box below and circle the appropriate team. Fellowship Dinners are on the second Wednesdays and fourth Tuesdays of most months. Set up is from 5:15 to 6 p.m with a crew of two or three. Clean up is from 6:45 to 7:45 p.m with a crew of six to eight.

   

### Greeting Visitors

Arrive at church about 1/2 hour before the worship service to greet visitors, help them fill out the guest registry form and make a nametag. Stay about 1/2 hour after service to talk with visitors. Includes set up and clean up of Greeters' station. A good fit for people who feel comfortable speaking with folks they don't know.

   

### Ushering

Arrive at church about 1 hour before the worship service to fold the Order of Service, hand it out to attendees, help people find seats if needed, pass the offering baskets, count attendees and count the offering.

### Rotating Teams

Instead of four of the above tasks, you could serve as a part of one of the teams who share the duties of arranging flowers, selling grocery certificates, running the sound system, hanging art shows, tracking the use of visitor nametags, arranging the pews, cooking our Fellowship Dinners, or serving on mailing crews, telephone teams, or facilities clean up or gardening work parties. Rotations are on a once every four to twelve week time frame, depending on the team. Circle the team you'd like to join, or check this box  if you'd like Volunteer Coordinator Pat Emery to call you to tell you more about the teams before you choose.
